On or about the 1st day of April, 2010, in Monroe County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully and knowingly participate in a riot, in violation of T.C.A. 39-17-302, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 2

The Grand Jurors upon their oath do present that

WALTER F. FITZPATRICK III

DARREN WESLEY HUFF

On or about the 1st day of April, 2010, in Monroe County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, with intent to prevent or disrupt a lawful meeting, procession, or gathering, substantially obstruct or interfere with the meeting procession, or gathering by physical action or verbal utterance, in violation of T.C.A. 39-17-306, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 3

The Grand Jurors upon their oath do present that

WALTER F. FITZPATRICK III

on or about the 1st day of April, 2010, in Monroe County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, intentionally, or knowingly in a public place and with intent to cause public annoyance or alarm, create a hazardous or physically offensive condition by an act that served no legitimate purpose, in violation of T.C.A. 39-17-305, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 4

The Grand Jurors upon their oath do present that

WALTER F. FITZPATRICK III

On or about the 1st day of April, 2010, in Monroe County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully and intentionally prevent or obstruct Travis Jones, known by the defendant to be a law enforcement officer, from effecting an arrest, by using force against the said law enforcement officer, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-602, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 5

The Grand Jurors upon their oath do present that

WALTER F. FITZPATRICK III


On or about the 1st day of April, 2010, in Monroe County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully and knowingly harm or threaten to harm a juror, Gary Pettway, by an unlawful act in retaliation for actions taken by Gary Pettway in an official capacity as a juror, in violation of T.C.A. 39-16-510, all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.

COUNT 6

The Grand Jurors upon their oath do present that

WALTER F. FITZPATRICK III

On or between the 2nd day of December, 2009, and the 1st day of April, 2010, in Monroe County, Tennessee, and before the finding of this indictment, did unlawfully, intentionally, or knowingly, coerce another, Gary Pettway, with the intent to unlawfully intimidate Gary Pettway because he exercised a right or privilege secured by the Constitution or laws of the United States or the Constitution or laws of the State of Tennessee, in violation of T.C.A. 39-17-309(b)(2), all of which is against the peace and dignity of the State of Tennessee.








