MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

COMES NOW, Plaintiff, pro se, and moves for a preliminary injunction requiring prison officials to return the BCCX Annex library to its former hours. As grounds, Plaintiff avers that BCCX prison officials have cut library hours from 7:00 am - 8:45 pm, daily, to 8:00 am - 3:00 pm, six days a week. This change was done in retaliation for the settlement agreement that TDOC & Plaintiff were about to enter into regarding this case. Indeed, TDOC Commissioner Tony Parker signed a settlement agreement on March 21, 2018 and the library hours changed on April 2, 2018, after approximately 30 years of the same schedule. In addition to the suspicious timing, ~~an~~ inmate Richard King, the librarian, told Plaintiff that they took the hours because of all his grievances. Plaintiff respectfully requests a hearing by telephone on this issue.
