THE RESPONDENT: YES.

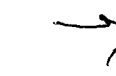
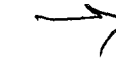
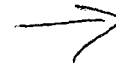
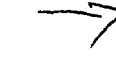
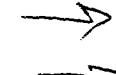
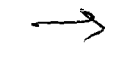
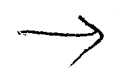
