The Combined Logistics Captains Career Course (CLC3) provides advanced level training in company leadership, operational planning functions, branch specific skills, and multifunctional logistics skills. Successful completion of CLC3 prepares officers to assume the duties of company commander and multifunctional logistics battalion or brigade level staff officers. CPT Mason was a student of the Midgrade Learning Continuum 2015 (MLC 2015) Common Core at Fort Lee, Virginia. The School of Advanced Leadership and Tactics (SALT), Command and General Staff College developed the curriculum, and it is designed to achieve application or higher cognitive levels in the areas of Mission Command, Culture, Unified Land Operations, Operations, Leadership and Communications, Training, and Company Level Combat Operations consistent with the Law of War. The learning objectives of the new common core curriculum exceed the learning levels required in the current CLC3. Implementation Army wide is expected in FY 2015. CPT Gary Mason II possesses many dynamic qualities that will serve him and the Army well throughout what will be an outstanding career. A natural leader, Gary could be counted on to motivate his fellow students and "make them better" during all phases of the Combined Logistics Captains Career Course. Despite being branched Infantry/Public Affairs, CPT Mason learned enough about logistics during the conduct of the course and is now a competent logistician on par with most of his peers who have much more experience and training as logisticians. He was a regular contributor during class discussions during all phases of the course and did much to facilitate a positive learning environment in the classroom. Further, he actively sought out those students, including Allied student that he sponsored (1LT Dieye - Senegal), who needed extra help and assisted them in overcoming their deficiencies. His ability to motivate and inspire his fellow students was especially evident during the MDMP and Tactical Logistics Exercise portions of the Multifunctional Phase of the course. CPT Mason absolutely must command a company, to both the benefit of the Soldiers he leads and the Army in general. 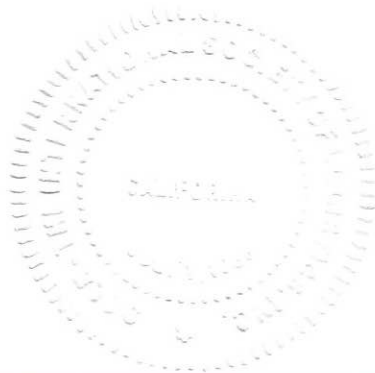
