Dear Madam Secretary Merrill:

Please find attached with this letter 2 additional Connecticut Voters that have same or similar names, same address, same town and same birth date. (That makes 105 in the past week.) These Registered Connecticut voters appear to have, according to the Voter Roll Database, which we purchased from your office, voted twice during the November 3, 2020 election. You will also find a list of voters that according to the Voter Roll Database, were under the age of 18 and appear to have voted in the November 3, 2020 election.

We are giving you this information as a courtesy "heads up." We have already filed with the SEEC and proper Federal authorities. Again, how does this happen?

Our nonprofit organization believes in election integrity and "One vote for one legal voter." © If you would like to discuss this matter, we would be happy to meet with you and review not only the above voter issues, but others that may have violated our election laws. Dominic Rapini, my Board Chair and I welcome the opportunity to meet and discuss the numerous other filings we will be making and how the issues can be fixed.
